RE: Presentation on the Task Force on Long-Term Sustainability of Affordable Housing

Dear Chair Port, Lead Lucero and Members of the Committee,

Thank you for hearing the presentation from the Task Force on Long-Term Sustainability of Affordable Housing. The task force report provides an overview of the current challenges experienced by owners, operators and residents of affordable housing and offers actionable recommendations to address these challenges.

Minnesota is a national leader in developing and preserving affordable housing through public-private partnerships. Our affordable housing system is robust and complex, including public investment from all levels of government, local policy that supports housing production, experienced and committed private sector owner-operators, significant private capital investment, and residents who reside in these homes. The task force report highlights the need for targeted interventions to protect our collective investments in the affordable housing supply that thousands of Minnesota housings depend on.

Please consider and support the implementation of the task force's recommendations. The recommendations focus on strengthening our affordable housing system by recognizing and addressing current economic challenges. They include conducting research and evaluations to improve the effectiveness of our investments, developing new or improving existing policies, tools, strategies, programs, and practices, and encouraging local policies that stimulate housing production.

The Greater Minnesota Housing Fund (GMHF) is a non-profit housing intermediary and Community Development Finance Institution (CDFI) with a mission to support the creation of strong communities and affordable homes through strategic investments and effective partnerships. GMHF has a 28-year history of supporting research, evaluation, analysis, demonstration projects, and the creation of new and innovative programs to address Minnesota's housing needs. In addition, we raise low-cost capital to directly invest in the production and preservation of affordable housing across Minnesota. GMHF works with Minnesota communities, including cities, towns, rural areas, and Tribal nations to support their local housing needs.
