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relating to local government; prohibiting minimum parking mandates; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 462.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. [462.3655] MINIMUM PARKING MANDATES PROHIBITED.

- (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, home rule charter, or ordinance to the contrary, a political subdivision shall not impose minimum parking mandates for residential, commercial, or industrial properties within its jurisdiction.
- (b) For purposes of this section, "minimum parking mandate" means a law, rule, or ordinance that specifies a minimum number of off-street motor vehicle parking spaces, including within a garage or other enclosed area, except that additional disability parking spaces may be required to meet the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- 1.13 (c) This section does not prohibit a political subdivision from passing an ordinance under 1.14 section 169.346, subdivision 4, related to disability parking spaces.
- (d) This section does not prohibit a political subdivision from offering a nonbinding
 recommendation for a property within its jurisdiction to provide a specified number of
 parking spaces.
