1.5	Section 1. TRANSFER; HOUSING DEVELOPMENT FUND.
1.6	\$2,000,000 in fiscal year 2026 is transferred from the general fund to the housing
1.7	development fund. This is a onetime transfer.
1.8	Sec. 2. APPROPRIATION; HOUSING ASSISTANCE.
1.9	Subdivision 1. Appropriation; rental assistance and eviction prevention. \$2,000,000
1.10	in fiscal year 2026 is appropriated from the housing development fund to the commissioner
