

**Senator Hoffman from the Committee on Human Services, to which was referred**


**S.F. No. 1175:** A bill for an act relating to human services; establishing a presumptive disability determination process for medical assistance eligibility; amending Minnesota Statutes 2024, sections 245D.02, subdivision 23; 256.01, subdivisions 18f, 29; 256B.055, subdivision 7, by adding a subdivision; 256B.056, subdivisions 1b, 3, 4, 10, by adding a subdivision; 256B.057, subdivision 12, by adding a subdivision; 256B.0761, subdivision 2; 256B.77, subdivision 7a.

Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

Page 6, delete lines 12 to 15 and insert:

"(1) the applicant screens positive for a newborn screening condition, including heritable or congenital disorders on the commissioner of health's list of tests to be administered and the applicant requires diagnostic testing or treatment as a result of the positive screen;"

And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Health and Human Services. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
