BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION; CHANGE THE OUTCOME ONGOING FUNDING.

\$500,000 in fiscal year 2026 and \$500,000 in fiscal year 2027 are appropriated from the

1.6

general fund to the commissioner of health for a grant to Change the Outcome to provide:

(1) data-centered learning opportunities on the dangers of opioid use in middle and high

1.8

schools and communities in Minnesota;

(2) instruction on prevention strategies, assessing personal risk, and how to recognize

overdose;

(3) information on emerging drug trends including but not limited to fentanyl, xylazine,

and pressed pills; and

(4) access to resources, including support for those struggling with substance use

1.14

disorders.
