1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 256B.4911, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.8	Subd. 4a. Budget exception for persons with developmental disabilities and type 1
1.9	diabetes. (a) The commissioner must establish a consumer-directed community supports
1.10	budget exception process for persons with both developmental disabilities and type 1 diabetes
1.11	in the home and community-based services waivers under sections 256B.092 and 256B.49.
1.12	This budget exception process must be available for any person who has both of the following
1.13	diagnoses documented in the person's assessment under section 256B.0911:
1.14	(1) a developmental disability; and
1.15	(2) type 1 diabetes.
1.16	(b) The amount of the exception must be an annualized amount equal to nine hours per
1.17	day at the current rate for home care nursing provided by a registered nurse under the

1.20	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective January 1, 2026, or upon federal approval,
