

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 2647 as follows:

1.2 Page 1, delete section 1 and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 245G.05, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.4 Subdivision 1. **Comprehensive assessment.** (a) A comprehensive assessment of the
1.5 client's substance use disorder must be administered face-to-face ~~by an alcohol and drug~~
1.6 ~~counselor~~ within five calendar days from the day of service initiation for a residential
1.7 program or by the end of the fifth day on which a treatment service is provided in a
1.8 nonresidential program. The number of days to complete the comprehensive assessment
1.9 excludes the day of service initiation.

1.10 (b) A comprehensive assessment must be administered by:

1.11 (1) an alcohol and drug counselor;

1.12 (2) a mental health professional who meets the qualifications under section 245I.04,
1.13 subdivision 2, practices within the scope of their professional licensure, and has training in
1.14 addiction, co-occurring disorders, and substance use disorder diagnosis and treatment
1.15 according to the requirements in section 245G.13, subdivision 2, paragraph (f);

1.16 (3) a clinical trainee who meets the qualifications under section 245I.04, subdivision 6,
1.17 practicing under the supervision of a mental health professional who meets the requirements
1.18 of clause (2); or

1.19 (4) an advanced practice registered nurse as defined in section 148.171, subdivision 3,
1.20 who practices within the scope of their professional licensure and has training in addiction,
1.21 co-occurring disorders, and substance use disorder diagnosis and treatment according to
1.22 the requirements in section 245G.13, subdivision 2, paragraph (f).

1.23 (c) If the comprehensive assessment is not completed within the required time frame,
1.24 the person-centered reason for the delay and the planned completion date must be documented
1.25 in the client's file. The comprehensive assessment is complete upon a qualified staff member's
1.26 dated signature. If the client received a comprehensive assessment that authorized the
1.27 treatment service, ~~an alcohol and drug counselor~~ a staff member qualified under paragraph
1.28 (b) may use the comprehensive assessment for requirements of this subdivision but must
1.29 document a review of the comprehensive assessment and update the comprehensive
1.30 assessment as clinically necessary to ensure compliance with this subdivision within
1.31 applicable timelines. ~~An alcohol and drug counselor~~ A staff member qualified under
1.32 paragraph (b) must sign and date the comprehensive assessment review and update."
