1.5Section 1. APPROPRIATION; MINNESOTA FAMILY RESILIENCY

1.6PARTNERSHIP.

1.7\$350,000 in fiscal year 2026 and \$350,000 in fiscal year 2027 are appropriated from the

1.8workforce development fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development

1.9for the Minnesota Family Resiliency Partnership under Minnesota Statutes, section 116L.96.

1.10The commissioner, through the adult career pathways program, shall distribute the funds

1.11to existing nonprofit and state displaced homemaker programs. These are onetime

1.12appropriations.
