For 32 years, we have been empowering youth through a year-long mentorship program, pairing them with caring adults who support goal-setting and personal development. Mentors and youth commit to meeting weekly for 2-4 hours, engaging in structured activities that promote physical, social, and emotional wellness. Youth set both physical and future-focused goals, learning to break them into achievable steps. With consistent support, encouragement, and accountability, they build confidence, resilience, and access to life-changing opportunities.



86% of youth paired with a mentor successfully complete a full year of weekly mentorship with Bolder Options (vs. the national average of 50%).

Funding Request

\$500,000 in fiscal year 2026 and \$500,000 in fiscal year 2027 are appropriated from the workforce development fund for a grant to provide middle and high school-aged youth with intensive one-to-one wellness and goal-oriented mentorship; programming that teaches life and job-seeking skills; access to career coaches and other mentors; and connections to employment, job training, and education opportunities. The grant will serve youth in the Bolder Options program in the Twin Cities and Rochester.
