PUC's Career Pathways program turns young adult's **interests into income**. With the initial investment in 2023, PUC was able to launch a new program to meet the needs of youth needing to enter the workforce, and provide a career pathway and supportive services to help young adults complete their training and enter their career. Youth receive paid training and tuition, one on one guidance, and intensive supports to succeed.

Career Pathways is for those who cannot afford **to not** work full time, especially to attend school, because they are the **primary providers in their household.** The result is young people being stuck in minimum wage positions with little opporutnity for advancement and wage growth.

We financially support people entering a 2 semester, or less, vocational training program. Program costs are: the cost of the training program, staff, and wraparound services. Services may include housing or transportation support, childcare allowance, food access support, tutoring, mental health counseling, debt relief counseling, etc. all supports are to remove barriers so students can take this time in their life to enter a long lasting, and well paying career.
