

1.1 Senator ..... moves to amend S.F. No. 730 as follows:

1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 13.65, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.4 Subdivision 1. **Private data.** The following data created, collected and maintained by  
1.5 the Office of the Attorney General are private data on individuals or nonpublic data:

1.6 (a) the record, including but not limited to, the transcript and exhibits of all disciplinary  
1.7 proceedings held by a state agency, board or commission, except in those instances where  
1.8 there is a public hearing;

1.9 (b) communications and noninvestigative files regarding administrative or policy matters  
1.10 which do not evidence final public actions;

1.11 (c) consumer complaint data, other than those data classified as confidential, including  
1.12 consumers' complaints against businesses and follow-up investigative materials;

1.13 (d) investigative data, obtained in anticipation of, or in connection with litigation or an  
1.14 administrative proceeding where the investigation is not currently active; and

1.15 (e) data collected by the Consumer Division of the Attorney General's Office in its  
1.16 administration of the home protection hot line including: the name, address, and phone  
1.17 number of the consumer; the name and address of the mortgage company; the total amount  
1.18 of the mortgage; the amount of money needed to bring the delinquent mortgage current;  
1.19 the consumer's place of employment; the consumer's total family income; and the history  
1.20 of attempts made by the consumer to renegotiate a delinquent mortgage.

1.21 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment."
