

## S.F. No. 456 – Endangerment From Fentanyl Exposure

Current law prohibits a person from knowingly causing or permitting a child or vulnerable adult to inhale, be exposed to, have contact with, or ingest methamphetamine. A violation is a five-year felony. **SF No. 456** adds an identical prohibition for fentanyl.
