



S.F. No. 737 – School bus stop arm violation penalty increase

S.F. 737 increases the statutory penalties for violations of the school bus stop arm law. Under current law, a person who fails to stop a vehicle or keep it stopped for a displayed stop arm signal is guilty of a misdemeanor and punishable by a fine of not less than \$500. **S.F. 737** increases the fine amount to not less than **\$700** for a violation occurring within ten years of a prior violation and not less than **\$950** for a violation occurring within ten years of two or more violations.
