

## S.F. No. 599 – Brady-Giglio Designations, Prosecutor Responsibilities

**S.F. No. 599** requires prosecutors that have made or are about to make a Brady-Giglio designation to provide a process for peace officers to challenge the designation. Requires prosecutors to adopt a policy addressing the criteria used to make designations and grants officers certain rights relating to the process. Defines "Brady-Giglio designation." Requires prosecutors to keep a peace officer's personnel file and related materials confidential. Also does this for data related to officer disciplinary proceedings and complaints. Prohibits peace officers from being discharged or disciplined solely due to a prosecutor making a determination or disclosure that exculpatory evidence exists concerning the officer.
