

S.F. No. 319 – Adulterating or Altering a Controlled Substance with Fentanyl

Section 1, subd. 1, par. (a) creates a felony offense for persons who knowingly adulterate or alter a controlled substance or drug with fentanyl, or substitutes a controlled substance or drug with fentanyl.

Paragraph (b) creates a felony offense for persons who knowingly adulterate or alter any package or receptacle containing a controlled substance or drug with fentanyl, or substitutes any package containing a controlled substance with a package containing fentanyl.

Paragraph (c) exempts manufacturers, practitioners, pharmacists, owners of pharmacies, nurses or other persons acting in a professional capacity from the provisions in the bill.

Section 2 defines "controlled substance" and "drug" for the purposes of the bill.
