1.6 Subd. 7. **Test refusal; driving privilege lost.** (a) On behalf of the commissioner, a peace  
1.7 officer requiring a test or directing the administration of a chemical test shall serve immediate  
1.8 notice of intention to revoke and of revocation on a person who refuses to permit a test or  
1.9 on a person who submits to a test the results of which indicate an alcohol concentration of  
1.10 0.08 or more.

1.11 (b) On behalf of the commissioner, a peace officer requiring a test or directing the  
1.12 administration of a chemical test of a person driving, operating, or in physical control of a  
1.13 commercial motor vehicle shall serve immediate notice of intention to disqualify and of  
1.14 disqualification on a person who refuses to permit a test, or on a person who submits to a  
1.15 test the results of which indicate an alcohol concentration of 0.04 or more.

1.16 (c) The officer shall:

1.17 (1) invalidate the person's driver's license or permit card;

1.18 (2) issue the person a temporary license effective for only ~~seven~~ 14 days; and

1.19 (3) send the notification of this action to the commissioner along with the certificate  
1.20 required by subdivision 3 or 4.""
