Section 1 [17.995] describes the Minnesota 4R Agricultural Grants program.

Subdivision 1 establishes a grant program to promote the use of certain nutrient management practices.

Subdivision 2 describes the eligible grant recipients as licensed fertilizer retailers who work towards certification of approved nutrient management practices.

Subdivision 3 requires the commissioner to specify the approved nutrient management practices that would be eligible for grants.

Subdivision 4 describes the types of grants available.

Subdivision 5 specifies that data collected as part of the grant administration process are nonpublic.

Subdivision 2 is a blank appropriation for the program.
