### **Bill Description**

The bill requires an attestation from the resident's representative in a long-term care facility that the resident has been medically determined to lack the ability to understand to consent to electronic monitoring. A resident in a nursing home has a right to be free from retaliation and may bring an action against a nursing home. Employees of a nursing home must have annual training on preventing retaliation.

The bill removes an expired paragraph and requires the department to publish on the website a report on the fines collected and how the appropriated money was allocated. It expands the Home Care and Assisted Living Program Advisory Council from 13 to 15 members and adds additional topics to provide advice on. It adds additional language to the Hospice Bill of Rights. It amends assisted living arbitration and medical management language, defines "registered nurse", and amends language pertaining to health care directives.

#### **Assumptions**

This bill adds two additional members to the Home Care and Assisted Living Program Advisory Council. Based on the departments experience managing this council, we require the following. The department will need to draft a notice of appointment, update the Secretary of State's website and review applications for the two new positions. In addition, the two new members will receive a \$55 per diem each. Each member will be compensated \$8 per meeting for parking.

This bill adds additional language to the Hospice Bill of Rights. The department will need to update the documents on the website including any documents that need to be translated.

The department must publish on the website a report on the fines collected and how the appropriated money was allocated.
