This Bill modifies medical cannabis provisions to include Tribal medical cannabis boards and respective medical cannabis programs. Also modifies the medical cannabis provisions to ensure individuals utilizing the programs have access to housing and education without retaliation.

Assumptions

Programs are being maintained by Tribal Nations for Tribal medical programs and boards, and the Office of Cannabis Management (OCM) for the state's medical cannabis program. The Minnesota Department of Health would not experience fiscal impacts as the medical cannabis program has moved to OCM.

Bill Description

The bill amends Minnesota Statutes Chapter 342 Cannabis to establish the ability of federally recognized Tribal governments for the creation of a governing body for oversight and compliance programs for Tribal medical cannabis programs.

Assumptions

The Board of Pharmacy licenses pharmacist as part of its normal duties. Chapter 342, currently authorizes medical cannabis retailers to utilize licensed pharmacists and other individuals specified to authorize final approval for distribution of medical cannabis to patients. The bill if enacted, would allow the same constructs for Tribal governments. While these individuals must be licensed under Chapter 151, the board does not have any involvement with Chapter 342 and would expect board involvement to be minimal and with no significant fiscal impacts.
