

## **S.F. No. 2499 – Modifying reporting of emergency medical services overdose data**

**S.F. No. 2499** (amends Minn. Stat. § 144E.123, subd. 3; Review) permits the director of the Office of Emergency Medical Services to share certain prehospital care data, specifically incident level location data, with the Overdose Detection Mapping Application Program (ODMAP). ODMAP is managed by the Washington/Baltimore High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area and provides near real-time suspected overdose data nationwide.
