

WATER STORAGE TANK FUNDING

Public Purpose

To construct a ground storage tank to replace two existing tanks (pictured right), thereby improving water quality.

City Action

The City is constructing a new concrete 2.0-million-gallon storage tank for the primary purpose of supplying potable water to Fairmont's West Industrial Park. The tank will replace two 1.4-million-gallon tanks that were originally constructed to hold ammonia before the City purchased and rehabilitated them in 1972. This new storage tank will increase water quality and take tanks that were originally built over 90 years ago out of service.

Projected Schedule

Spring 2025 thru end of 2025

Cost of Construction/Engineering \$4.5 M
