## **EXPLANATION OF THE BILL**

The bill would exempt materials and supplies used or consumed in and equipment incorporated into the construction of a county government center in the city of Foley in Benton County. The exemption would be administered as a refund and apply to purchases made after March 31, 2025, and before January 1, 2030.

## REVENUE ANALYSIS DETAIL

- The estimate is based on project information provided by Benton County.
- The total project cost is estimated to be \$29.1 million.
- The total cost of materials is estimated to be \$9.3 million.
- The project will begin in July 2025 and complete in December 2026. The distribution of expected refund claims is assumed based on the project timeline.
