

S.F. No. 1579 – Establishing Property Tax Exemption for Certain Property Owned by an Indian Tribe

SF 1579 authorizes a property tax exemption for property located in Minneapolis and owned by the Leech Lake Band of Ojibwe. The property is identified as the Leech Lake Twin Cities Office located at 2438 27th Avenue S, Minneapolis. The exemption is limited to one parcel that does not exceed 40,000 square feet, and any property used for single-family housing, market-rate apartments, agriculture, or forestry does not qualify.

Effective beginning with assessment year 2026.
