

## S.F. No. 1633 – Class 2c Managed Forest Land

Under current law, land is eligible for Class 2c – Managed Forest Land – if the property is no less than 20 acres and no more than 1,920 acres, not enrolled in the Sustainable Forest Recourse Management Incentive Program (SFIA) and is managed under a forest management plan that meets the requirement of the SFIA chapter.

SF 1633 eliminates the requirement that the property's forest management plan meets all of the requirements of the SFIA chapter, and provides that the property's forest management plan must meet the requirements as provided in Minnesota Statutes, section 290C.02, subdivision 7, and that the plan be written by an approved plan writer as defined in Minnesota Statutes, section 290C.02, subdivision 2.
