LEE & ROSE WARNER COLISEUM

In 2025 and 2026, the State Fair will invest an estimated \$22 million in the Warner Coliseum, the centerpiece of youth and open-class livestock and horse exhibitions and dozens of year-round events. This project, the first significant update in the building's almost 75-year history, will

enhance the experience for tens of thousands of guests and benefit exhibitors who travel from across the state. Planned upgrades include replacing the leaking roof, modernizing mechanical and electrical systems, installing new seats and railings, expanding restroom capacity, renovating entryways, and improving lighting, ventilation and accessibility.



4-H BUILDING



Thousands of 4-H'ers from across the state converge on the State Fairgrounds to showcase the knowledge and skills they've gained throughout the year and continue their learning. The 4-H Building includes spaces for performances,

demonstrations, exhibits, dorms and a cafeteria. In addition to ongoing maintenance and improvement projects, a focus in 2025 is replacing the aging roof.
