

S.F. No. 2116 – Modifying the calculation of town aid and increasing the annual town aid appropriation

Section 1. Towns. Defines "town aid factor" as the product of a town's: (1) agricultural property factor; (2) town area factor; and (3) population factor. Modifies the town aid formula so that the total town appropriation is distributed and so that the aid amount to a town is proportional to its town aid factor. Effective beginning with aid payable in calendar year 2026 and thereafter.

Section 2. Appropriation. Increases the total town aid payable from \$10,000,000 to \$11,500,000. Effective beginning with aid payable in calendar year 2026 and thereafter.
