

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 3017 as follows:

1.2 Page 1, after line 5, insert:

1.3 "Section 1. Laws 1996, chapter 471, article 2, section 29, subdivision 1, as amended by
1.4 Laws 2006, chapter 259, article 3, section 3, Laws 2011, First Special Session chapter 7,
1.5 article 4, section 4, and Laws 2017, First Special Session chapter 1, article 5, section 6, is
1.6 amended to read:

1.7 Subdivision 1. **Sales tax authorized.** (a) Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section
1.8 477A.016, or any other contrary provision of law, ordinance, or city charter, the city of
1.9 Hermantown may, by ordinance, impose an additional sales tax of up to one percent on
1.10 sales transactions taxable pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, chapter 297A, that occur within
1.11 the city. The proceeds of the tax imposed under this section must be used to meet the costs
1.12 of:

1.13 (1) extending a sewer interceptor ~~line~~ lines;

1.14 (2) construction of a booster pump ~~station~~ stations, reservoirs, and related improvements
1.15 to the water system; and

1.16 (3) construction of a building containing a police and fire station and an administrative
1.17 services facility.

1.18 (b) If the city imposed a sales tax of only one-half of one percent under paragraph (a),
1.19 it may increase the tax to one percent to fund the purposes under paragraph (a) provided it
1.20 is approved by the voters at a general election held before December 31, 2012.

1.21 (c) As approved by the voters at the November 8, 2016, general election, the proceeds
1.22 under this section may also be used to meet the costs of debt service payments for
1.23 construction of the Hermantown Wellness Center.

1.24 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment without
1.25 local approval pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 645.023, subdivision 1."
