

1.1 Senator moves to amend the delete-everything amendment (SCS2374A-4)
1.2 to S.F. No. 2374 as follows:

1.3 Page 74, line 18, delete everything after "effective" and insert "January 1, 2026."

1.4 Page 98, line 4, delete "\$14,730,000" and insert "\$14,430,000"

1.5 Page 139, after line 8, insert:

1.6 "Sec. 7. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 469.1813, subdivision 5, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 5. **Notice and public hearing.** (a) The governing body of the political subdivision
1.8 may approve an abatement under sections 469.1812 to 469.1815 only after holding a public
1.9 hearing on the abatement.

1.10 (b) Notice of the hearing must be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the
1.11 political subdivision at least once ~~more than~~ at least ten days but less than 30 days before
1.12 the hearing. The newspaper must be one of general interest and readership in the community,
1.13 and not one of limited subject matter. The newspaper must be published at least once per
1.14 week. The notice must indicate that the governing body will consider granting a property
1.15 tax abatement, identify the property or properties for which an abatement is under
1.16 consideration, and the total estimated amount of the abatement."

1.17 Page 205, line 16, delete "4" and insert "22"

1.18 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references

1.19 Amend the title accordingly
