


Veteran Community Based Services Regional Map & Veteran Suicides











Minnesota Veteran Suicide by Region

















Age & Sex Demographics




Mechanism of Injury Veterans vs. Non-Veterans


Mission

Claims Offices

- Represents Veterans and their dependents who seek federal Veteran benefits
- compensation, non-service-connected pension, survivor benefits, vocational rehabilitation or educational benefits
- Supports appeals process with the US Dept. of Veterans Affairs before the Board of Veterans Appeals
- Offices located out of the St Paul VA Regional Office and Fargo VA Regional Office
- Work closely with the 87 County Veteran Service Officers

Field Operations

- ➤ Mobile Unit of the MDVA Claims
 Division with flexibility to travel to those in need
- Assist Veterans and their dependents with mobility issues and other barriers to accessing their benefits and services
- Medical Center Services

- Supporting Veterans at MDVA Veteran Homes with benefits and services

Work in Progress

Veteran Suicide Prevention

- Assessing areas with higher rates of Veteran death by suicide to guide resources and support needs
- Implementing standards of work with training and education
- Developing an education strategy to reach internal staff and community members
- Developing and implementing upstream approaches to identify Veterans to support their social determinants of health needs to assist before a crisis

Veteran Health Navigator

- Job descriptions have been developed and submitted to HR for review – anticipating to post April and have staff in place by June
- Have identified rural healthcare systems once staff are in place a solicitation will be posted for healthcare systems to apply
- Collaborated with MDH Office of Rural Health and Primary Care on submitting HRSA Rural Veteran Health Assess Program grant

- Working with MDH Suicide Prevention
 Plan & Taskforce to bring the
 collaborative under the umbrella to share
 resources and align work with state
 initiatives
- Developing goals and objectives with partners across the state
- Developing a strategy with Mpls. VA
 Community & Engagement Partnership
 Coordinator for Ask the Question
 Campaign to identify Veterans
- Collaborating efforts with the American Legion Be the One Campaign and the Columbia Lighthouse Project with training to community members on talking with Veterans who may be at risk for suicide
