

In the matter of the Proposed Rules

the Bonding of Vendors.

STATEMENT OF NEED AND REASONABLENESS

The need to adopt parts 8220.0650 and 8220.0800 arise from the requirements of C 362 Laws of 1986 which mandate the Secretary of State to bond vendors of voting machines or programs for votings in the state of Minnesota.

1. Part 8220.0650 will implement the requirements of Laws of 1986 C 362 s 7 for vendors of voting machines or electronic voting systems to deposit a bond with the Secretary of State as part of the process for certification of those machines or systems for use in Minnesota elections, as provided in section 206.57. The amendment is based on recommendations of the Secretary of State's Advisory Task Force on Punch Card Voting.
2. Part 8220.0800 will implement the requirement of laws of 1986 C 362 s 9 which provides that each vendor who prepares a program for an electronic voting system shall deposit a bond with the Secretary of State. The part is based on recommendations of the State of State's Advisory Task Force on Punch Card Voting.
