## Ordinance No. 107

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX ADDITIONAL LAND TO THE VILLAGE OF LE ROY AND EXTEND THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF.

The village council of Le Roy do ordain;

Section 1. Additional land annexed and village boundary extended. Pursuant to petitions duly signed by the majority of owners of land abutting the village, and being and lying in Mower County, Minnespta and described as follows:

Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), and Six (6), Block One (1), and
