
A Proclamation of Purple Heart Day

In suitable recognition of the members of our Armed Forces whose wounds or injuries while under enemy action entitled them to wear the Purple Heart medal, the Department of Minnesota, Military Order of the Purple Heart, has chosen Friday, August 9, 1946, as Purple Heart Day for the purpose of selling and distributing the Purple Heart Flower.

Funds derived from the sale of Purple Heart flowers are used entirely for welfare, rehabilitation, and relief of needy and deserving veterans and their families.




