Whereas Hon. William J. Gallagher was duly nominated in the primary Election held in the State of Minnesota on July 8, 1946 as the Democratic-Farmer-Labor candidate for representative in the Congress of the United States of America from the Third Congressional District of the State of Minnesota, and whereas said Hon.
