PETITION FOR ANNECKATION OF LAND UNDER MINN. STATS., SEC. 413.12
(MASON'S MINN. STATS., SECS. 1845-1849)

For annexation of Territory to the Village of New Brighton
To the Village Council of New Brighton

Re annexation of the following described territory:

All of that land bounded by the lines hereinafter specifically described. Beginning at the West 1/4 corner of Sec. 18, T. 30 N., R. 23W., thence running Easterly to the center of said section, thence South along the North and South 1/4 line of said section to the Southeast corner of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4, thence Easterly along the North line of the South 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of said Sec. 18 to the East line of said section, thence Southerly along the East line of Sec. 18 to the Southeast corner thereof; thence Easterly along the North line of Sec. 20, T. 30 N., R. 23 W., to the Northeast corner of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4, thence South along the 1/4-1/4 line of the West 1/2 of Sec. 20, T. 30 N., R. 23 W., to a point which is 458.98 feet North of the South line thereof; thence Easterly and parallel to the said South line of said section to a point on the North and South 1/4 line, thence Southerly along said 1/4 line to the South 1/4 corner of Sec. 20 in said Township and Range; thence continuing Southerly along the North and South 1/4 line of Sec. 29, T. 30 N., Range 23 W., to the South 1/4 corner thereof, thence Westerly along the South line of Sec. 29 to the Southwest corner of said section, thence continuing Westerly along the South line of Sec. 30, T. 30 N., R. 23 W., to the Southwest corner thereof; thence Northerly along the West lines of Sec. 30, Sec. 19, and Sec. 18, T. 30 N., R. 23 W., which is also the West line of Ramsey County, to the West 1/4 corner of Sec. 18, said Township and Range, which is the point of beginning.

RESOLUTION

Whereas, a petition has been filed with the Village Clerk asking for the annexation of the following described territory to the Village of New Brighton, New Brighton, Minn.

All of that land bounded by the lines hereinafter specifically described. Beginning at the West 1/4 corner of Sec. 18, T. 30 N., R. 23 W., thence running Easterly to the center of said section, thence South along the North and South 1/4 line of said section to the Southeast corner of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4, thence Easterly along the North line of the South 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of said Sec. 18 to the East line of said section, thence Southerly along the East line of Sec. 18 to the Southeast corner thereof; thence Easterly along the North line of Sec. 20, T. 30 N., R. 23 W., to the Northwest corner of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4, thence South along the 1/4-1/4 line of the West 1/3 of Sec. 20, T. 30 N., R. 23 W., to a point which is 450.98 feet North of the South line thereof; thence Easterly and parallel to the said South line of said section to a point on the North and South 1/4 line, thence Southerly along said 1/4 line to the South 1/4 corner of Sec. 20 in said Township and Range; thence continuing Southerly along the North and South 1/4 line of Sec. 20, T. 30 N., Range 23 W., to the South 1/4 corner thereof, thence Easterly along the South line of Sec. 20 to the Southwest corner of said section, thence continuing Easterly along the South line of Sec. 30, T. 30 N., R. 23 W., to the Southwest corner thereof; thence Northerly along the West lines of Sec. 30, Sec. 19, and Sec. 18, T. 30 N., R. 23 W., which is also the West line of Ramsey County, to the West 1/4 corner of Sec. 18, said Township and Range, which is the point of beginning.

And whereas, the Council deems it desirable to allow the voters of the territory to express themselves on the question of annexation as provided in Minnesota Statutes, Section 413.12.

Now therefore Be it Resolved that a special election be held in the above described territory on the question of annexation on Thursday August 29, 1946 from 7 A.M. to 8 P.M. at Guy E. Fredeen's Garage, Long Lake Road, Mounds View Township.

Be it further resolved that Mrs. Alice Olson, Joseph F. Bolony and Guy E. Fredeen Jr., residents of such territory, be appointed inspectors to act as judges of election and conduct the same so far as practicable in accordance with the law regulating the election of town officers.

Be it further resolved that the Clerk give notice of such election according to Law.
