A Proclamation of Parent-Teacher Month

Recognizing that the education and training of our children is one of the most vital responsibilities in our national life, the Minnesota Congress of Parents and Teachers has designated October as Parent-Teacher Enrollment Month in Minnesota.

Since the home and the school are agencies deeply affecting the lives of our boys and girls and their futures as responsible citizens and well-rounded and happy individuals, it is important that there be full opportunity for understanding and co-operation between parents and teachers. The Parent-Teacher Associations in every school district afford an agency wherein this mutuality of interest can be developed, while at the same time serving to focus the citizen's interest in the schools as a center of community life.

Following a custom of several years' standing I, therefore, proclaim the month of October, 1946, as Parent-Teacher Enrollment Month in Minnesota, and urge our parents and teachers to join together in effective teamwork for the fuller benefit of those who will be the citizens of tomorrow and whose characters and development will thus profoundly affect our American life.
