**ORDINANCE ANNEXING AND DECLARING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF HOPKINS.**

The Village Council of the Village of Hopkins do hereby ordain as follows: WHEREAS, the owners of the tracts, pieces or parcels of land abutting upon the Village of Hopkins which Village has been incorporated under the laws of the State of Minnesota and which Village has less than ten thousand inhabitants have petitioned the said Village of Hopkins to have the property hereinafter described annexed to said Village of Hopkins, all pursuant to Sections 1843 and 1844 Mason's Minnesota Statutes 1927.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained by the Village Council of said Village as follows:

Section 1. That the following described real estate situated in Hennepin County, Minnesota, viz:

The East One-half of the Southwest Quarter ( $E\frac{1}{2}$  of  $BW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirteen (13), Township One Hundred Seventeen (117), Range Twenty-two (22); also the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4}$  of  $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirteen (13), Township One Hundred Seventeen (117), Range Twenty-two (22); Also the Easterly 400 feet of that part of the West One-half of the Southwest Quarter ( $W\frac{1}{2}$  of  $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirteen (13), Township One Hundred Seventeen (117) Range Twenty-two (22), which formerly constituted the South One-half ( $S\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Lot Three (3), and all of Lots Four (4), Five (5), and Six (6), of Souba's Subdivision, Hennepin County, Minnesota, now vacated;

Also the Easterly Four Hundred (400) feet of Lot Seven (7), Souba's Subdivision, Hennepin County, Minnesota, now vacated.

is hereby annexed and declared to be an addition of and to the Village of Hopkins, the same to be a part of said Village of Hopkins as effectively as if it had been originally a part thereof.

Section 2. This ordinance is passed pursuant to Sections 1843 and 1844 Mason's Minnesota Statutes 1927 and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.
