

This is to certify that at the Annual Town Meeting in the
Town of Klondike in said county, held on the 12th. day of March, 1912,
the following question was submitted to the voters thereof:-

"Shall the village of Ironton be separated from the town of
Klondike for taxing and election purposes?"

Twenty-six votes were cast in favor of separation and four votes
were cast against it. The proposition was therefore carried, and
Ironton is henceforth a separate taxing district and voting precinct.
