

R E S O L U T I O N .

Commissioner P.F. Casey offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

W H E R E A S: A petition has been duly presented to the County Board of Stevens County, Minnesota, by twenty six legal voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, setting forth that the number of actual residents within said territory according to a census taken between the 11th and 13th days of March, 1913 is 104 persons; that said territory comprises three(3) sections, or 1920 acres of land, and praying that the territory hereinafter referred to, situate in Stevens county State of Minnesota, Viz: Beginning at the north west corner of section 4 Twp 134 Range 43, and running thence due east 2 miles to the north-east corner of Section 3, Twp 134 Rg 43, thence due south 1 and 1/2 miles to the south-east corner of the north-east quarter of Section 10, Twp 134 Rg 43 thence due west 2 miles to the south-west corner of the north-west quarter of Section 9, Twp. 134. Rg 43; thence due north to starting point; be incorporated into a village to be known and designated as Alberta, and praying that this Board call an election to be held in said territory at a time and place to be designated by this board as prescribed by law, at which election the matter of the incorporation of such village be submitted to the electors thereof as prescribed by law.

And it Appearing to this board that the said petition is in due form as required by law; and that said petition has been duly filed with the County Auditor of said County, and with this Board for its action thereon; And it appearing to this Board that the territory so sought to be incorporated is not now within the corporate limits of any city or Village of the State Of Minnesota, and that a portion thereof has been duly platted into lots and blocks as provided by law; that no newspaper is printed or published within said territory.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the County Board of Stevens County That The Said Petition Be, And the Same hereby is approved, and that the Prayer of said petitioners be granted; And be it further resolved that a special Election be and is hereby called to be held on the 1st day of May 1913, at the Town Hall in the town of Alberta, within the territory aforesaid, that due notice of said election be given by postin three notices thereof, as required by law, within the territory thus to be incorporated; and be it further resolved that such notice of said election be in the form hereto annexed and marked "Exhibit A", And be it further resolved that the following named persons Viz: L. M. Larson, T. A. Maanum and W. T. Pederson, be and thy are hereby appointed inspectors, they being residents of said territory, who will act as judges of said Election and conduct the same in accordance with the laws regulating the election of town officers, that form of ballot to be used at such election shall be as follows:—

of the last two words, in which the voter shall make a cross (x) mark to express his choice.

That after said election has been held the said inspectors shall make and file with the County Auditor a Certificate as required by law, showing the result of said election.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That pursuant to the attached petition, A Special Election will be held in the territory proposed to be incorporated in the annexed petition described and set forth, at the town of Alberta, in the Township of Scott, in Stevens County, Minnesota at the Town Hall in said Town Of Alberta, on the 1st day of May A.D. 1913, the purpose of said election, and the matter to be determined thereby is, whether or not the territory described and set forth in the annexed petition shall be incorporated as a village under and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter Nine (9) of the revised Laws Of Minnesota for the year 1905 and all acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto: That at such election the polls will be kept open from the hour of 9 A.M. to 5 O'clock P.M.

PETITION TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF ALBERTA

TO the Honorable Board Of Stevens County, Minnesota,
Greeting: legal

We the undersigned voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, lying and being in the County of Stevens And State of Minnesota, respectfully state and show to your Honorable Board as follows

1st That the number of persons residing within said territory hereinafter described, the census of which was taken between the 11th day of March and the 12th day of March 1913; were and are 104 persons.

2nd That the boundary of the territory to compose such incorporation is as follows:

Beginning on the NW corner of Section 4 Township 124 Range 43 Thence due east 2 miles to NE corner of Section 3 Township 124 Range 43 Thence due south 1 and 1/2 miles to SE corner of the NE 1/4 Sec 10 Twp 124 Range 43 Thence due north to starting point, containing 3 sections of land.

3d That the quantity of land embraced in said territory, described is 1980 acres.

4th that the the number of persons, actually residing within said territory is 104.

5th That the name of the Village when so incorporated shall be Alberta.

6th That the former Village Of Alberta organized under the Laws of this State, and containing the same territory as herebefore described and in addition thereto a large amount of other territory, has been declared void by a judgment of the Court duly made and entered on the 11 day of March 1913.

Now THEREFORE, We the said legal voters aforesaid residing within the territory above described do hereby respectfully petition your Honorable Board to call an election for the determination of such

incorporation pursuant to the laws of the State of Minnesota, being Chapter Nine of the Revised Laws of said State, for the year 1905, and all Acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto.

We, the undersigned inspectors duly appointed by the County Board of Stevens County, Minnesota, to act as Judges of the Special Election held on the 1st day of May 1912, in the Town of Alberta, in the Township of Scott, in Stevens County, Minnesota, to vote upon the question of the incorporation of the Village of Alberta; having duly acted as such judges at said election and conducted the same, do hereby respectfully report to the County Auditor of Stevens County, Minnesota, viz:

That we, as such inspectors and judges of election, aforesaid, were present at and acted as judges of said election held in the Town Hall in the Town of Alberta, in the Township of Scott, in Stevens County, Minnesota, which was held on the 1st day of May A.D. 1912, that the polls at said election were kept open from the hour of 9 o'clock A.M. to the hour of 5 o'clock P.M. of said day, continuously; that after the said polls were closed, we canvassed the votes cast at said election and found that the total number of votes so cast was Sixteen (16); that of said votes so cast, Fifteen (15) were in favor of the incorporation of said Village of Alberta, and One (1) were cast against the incorporation of said Village of Alberta.


