is printed or published within said territory.

W. Larson, T.A. Maanum and W.T. Pederson, be and thy are hereby appointed inspectors, they being residents of said territory, who willnot as judges of said Election and conduct the same in accordance with the laws regulating the election of town officers, that form of ballot to be used at such election shall be as follows:-

For Incorporation With a Square ofter each ľo of the last two words, in which the voter shall make a cross (x) mark to express his choice. That after said election has been held the said inspectors shall make and file with the County Auditor a Sertificate as regired by law, showing the result of soid election.
