The undersigned 39 voters, who have resided in the territory hereinafter described continuously for a period of at least two years prior to the date of this petition, hereby petition your honorable board to fix a time and place when and where the resident voters may vote on the proposition of incorporation of such territory as a village to be known by the name of the Village of Champlin. The territory proposed to be incorporated is described as follows :

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That Tuesday, the 8th day of October, 1946, between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M. be, and is hereby fixed as the time, and that the School House of School District No. 34 located at Summer and Fourth Streets, within the territory described in said petition, as the place where an election shall be held to determine whether or not the territory described in said petition shall be incorporated as the Village of Champlin.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That O. D. Schneidler, W. R. Swartout and Mrs. John Goodrich be, and they are hereby appointed inspectors who shall preside and act as judges at said election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That said O. D. Schneidler be, and he is hereby designated and appointed to post in three of the most public places in said territory a copy of said petition with notice attached, stating the time and place, when and where the voters residing in said territory will vote for or against such incorporation.
