That a special election was duly called by the Village Council of the Village of Nimrod, Wadena County, Minnesota, to be held on the 11th day of October, 1946, between the hours of two o'clock P. M. and seven o'clock P. M., at which election the following question was submitted to the voters of said Village of Nimrod:

" Shall the Village of Nimrod become a separate election and assessment district from the Township of Orton? "

That Mrs. Ann Stigman and Mrs. Myrl Nielsen were duly appointed judges of said election and conducted said election and canvassed all votes cast; that said judges of said election have duly certified said election to the Village Council, in which certificate the said judges have certified that the total number of votes cast in said election was 27, and that out of said total votes cast, 26 votes were cast for the separation and 1 vote was cast against the separation.

You will therefore file this certified report in your office and transmit one to the Secretary of State.
