**PETITION FOR INCORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF KORNICK
IN PINE COUNTY, MINNESOTA**

WE THE PETITIONERS OF COUNTY COURTHOUSE, of Pine County, in the State of Minnesota;

That petitioners being all voters and residing within the territory hereinabove named and do hereby petition your Honorable Body to call an election in such territory to vote upon the proposition of incorporating into a village to be known as the Village of Kornick, the following described territory located in said Pine County, to-wit:

Section 36, Township 46, North of Range 18 West of the 4th P. M., comprising 620 acres more or less in area according to the United States Government Survey thereof, inclusive of all public highways and right of way of the Great Northern Railway Company and including the platted Addition of Kornick.

That petitioners further allege that within said territory, is located the Addition of Kornick, which has been platted into lots and blocks, the plot thereof has been duly and legally certified according to the laws of the State and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said County of Pine, and that all of the unplatet lands above described are contiguous and adjacent to the platted portion of said area, to-wit: the Addition of Kornick, and your petitioners further allege that all of said territory and area both platted and unplatet are so contiguos as properly to be subject to Village Government.


