

ORDINANCE NO. 36

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF HANSKA, BROWN COUNTY, MINNESOTA,
EXTENDING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF HANSKA PURSUANT TO
SECTION 1120 OF MASON'S MINNESOTA STATUTES 1927 AND ACTS AMENDA-
TORY THEREOF

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HANSKA DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. That whereas, a petition has been duly filed with the
Village Council of the Village of Hanska by a majority of the owners of platted
land, not exceeding 200 acres, abutting upon the said Village of Hanska and which
said lands are described as follows, to-wit:

Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17,
18, 19 and 20, all in Sublot 6 of Lot "C" of the West half of
the Northeast quarter, Section 24, Township 108 North, of Range
31 West, and

Sublot 1 of Lot "C" of the West half of the Northeast quarter,
Section 24, Township 108 North, of Range 31 West, all according
to the plats thereof on file and of record in the office of the
Register of Deeds of Brown County, Minnesota,

and praying to have such lands included within the said Village of Hanska, and

Whereas, the Village Council has duly determined that the said petition
should be in all things granted,

Therefore, the Council herein do by this ordinance duly extend the
Village boundaries of the Village of Hanska so as to include all of the lands
above described and set out and that said lands shall in all things become a part
of the Village of Hanska with all the rights, incidents and obligations incident
thereto.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect from and after its
passage, approval and publication according to law, and after a certified copy
thereof has been duly filed with the Secretary of State in and for the State of
Minnesota, then said change of boundaries shall become operative and effective.
