I, Anton Peterson, County Auditor in and for the County of Kanabec and State of Minnesota, do hereby certify that on the 14th, day of March, A. D. 1912 there was filed in my office a certificate of the Village Recorder of the Village of Ogilvie, certifying that at the annual Village Election held on the 12th, day of March, 1912 there was submitted the question of separating the Village of Ogilvie from the Town of Kanabec into a separate assessment and election district to the electors of said Village. That there were sixty-nine (69) votes cast at said election of which forty-two were in favor of, and twenty-seven against such separation.

It appearing that a majority of the votes cast at said election are in favor of separating said Village of Ogilvie from the Town of Kanabec in said County of Kanabec and State of Minnesota so as to constitute a separate assessment and election district; therefore I further certify that I am favorable to the change.
