

PETITION FOR ANNEXATION  
TO VILLAGE OF  
LESTER PRAIRIE,

TO THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF LESTER PRAIRIE:

We, the undersigned, all owners of land abutting upon the village of Lester Prairie, owning a majority of the land described, consisting of less than two hundred (200) acres, which land is unplatted, do hereby petition the Village Council to annex all of said land to the Village and to extend the Village boundaries so as to include the same and all thereof.

The extended boundary shall be and is described as follows, viz:

Beginning at a point on the North line of Lester Prairie, which is the center line of Washington Avenue and is the East line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 2-116-27; thence North to a point on the East line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 2-116-27 which point is 835 feet South of the NE corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 2-116-27; thence West parallel to the North line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 2-116-27 to the East line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 2-116-27; thence South to the South line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 2; thence West to the West line of Section 2-116-27; thence South to a point 50 feet South of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 2-116-27 which is the South Right-of-way line of the Great Northern Railway Company; thence East along said Right-of-way 80 rods; thence South 39 rods; thence West 16 rods to the West line of Lot 23, Auditor's Plat of Section 2-116-27; thence South 50 rods to the SW corner of Lot 23; thence East along the South line of Lot 23 32 rods; thence North to a point where the East line of Lot 23 intersects the South line of 2nd Avenue South as produced West; thence East along the South line of 2nd Avenue produced West to the center line of Washington Avenue; thence East to the East boundary line of Irvington Avenue, thence North to the South line of 1st Avenue North; thence East 100 feet; thence North 150 feet; thence West 100 feet to the East
