We, O.E. Stewart, President, of the village Council,  
and Emil I. Erdal, Village Recorder of the Village of Bricelyn,  
in said County of Faribault and State of Minnesota, do hereby  
certify that in pursuance and in accordance with ~~the laws~~  
the Petition signed by resident voters duly presented to the  
Village Council and in pursuance to a Resolution passed by the  
Village Council and due notice given by the publication and  
posting of such notice as provided by law, a general Village  
election was held in said Village on the 18th day of March, 1912,  
at which election, the following question was voted on to-wit:  
" Shall the Village of Bricelyn, Faribault County, Minnesota,  
separate for all purposes from the Township of Seely, Faribault  
County, Minnesota, and become a separate election and assessment  
district."

A total of fifty-three ballots were cast upon the question,  
of forty-four were in favor of the separation and nine votes  
were against the separation, and that the said forty-four ballots  
so cast is a majority of the electors casting their ballots  
upon the said question at said election aforesaid.


