

PETITION FOR INCORPORATION OF VILLAGE

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Cass,
Minnesota:

The undersigned 25 voters, who have resided in the territory hereinafter described for a period of at least two years prior to the date of this petition, hereby petition your honorable board to fix a time and place when and where the resident voters may vote on the proposition of incorporation of such territory as a village to be known by the name of Pine Beach Landing. The territory proposed to be incorporated is described as follows:

Lot 4, Section 18,
Lot 6, Section 19,
All of Lots 1 to 19 inclusive, Pine Beach plat,
Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4; Section 30,
The SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the
SE $\frac{1}{4}$, and the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$, all in Section 30,
That part of Lot 6, Section 29, deeded to E. B. Curry,
All in Township 134, Range 29, Cass County, Minnesota.

Such territory consists of lands which have been partly platted into lots and blocks, which plat has been duly and legally certified according to the laws of this state and has been filed in the office of the register of deeds of Cass County, the county in which said lands lie, (and the unplatted part of such territory adjoins the platted portion and is so conditioned and properly to be subjected to village government). Such territory contains 2.26 acres of land and has actual residents thereon, and has been duly ascertained by a census taken under our direction on the 25th day of April, 1946 as appears by the verification hereto.

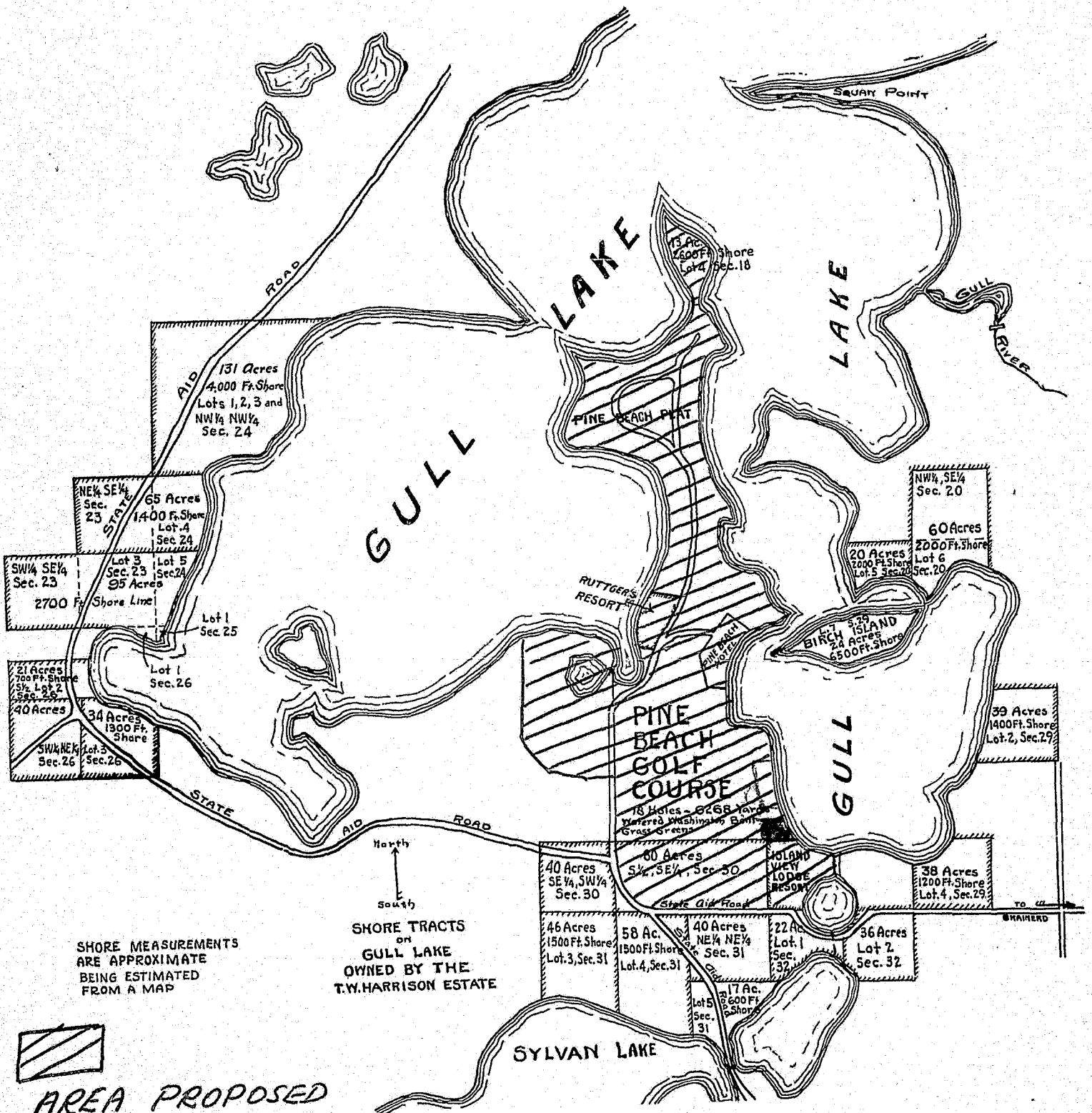


