KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Section 114 of Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, do hereby on request of the Commissioner of Highways constitute and appoint Harold S. Bjornstad of Saint Paul, Minnesota, Special Assistant Attorney General, and fix his compensation in the sum of \$5,000 per annum. This appointment is in addition to the appointment made by me at the request of the State Veterans Service Building Commission. His compensation shall be paid from and out of the funds appropriated to said commission, except for such time as may be devoted to the Department of Highways for which time he shall be compensated from the trunk highway fund. Said Special Assistant Attorney General shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. Said appointment shall take effect on the 6th day of January, 1947.
