KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 114, Mason's Minnesota Statutes 1927, and upon written request as in said section provided, do hereby constitute and appoint Lewis L. Anderson, of St. Paul, Minnesota, as Special Attorney for the Board of Registration for Architects, Engineers and Land Surveyors of the State of Minnesota, and fix his compensation at One Hundred (\$100) Dollars per month to be paid from and out of the funds of said board for attending its meetings and advising said board. In the event that the trial of cases in court or special work out of the ordinary shall become necessary, the amount to be paid therefor by the board out of its funds shall be agreed upon between the board and said attorney to be approved by the Attorney General. Said appointee shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law.
