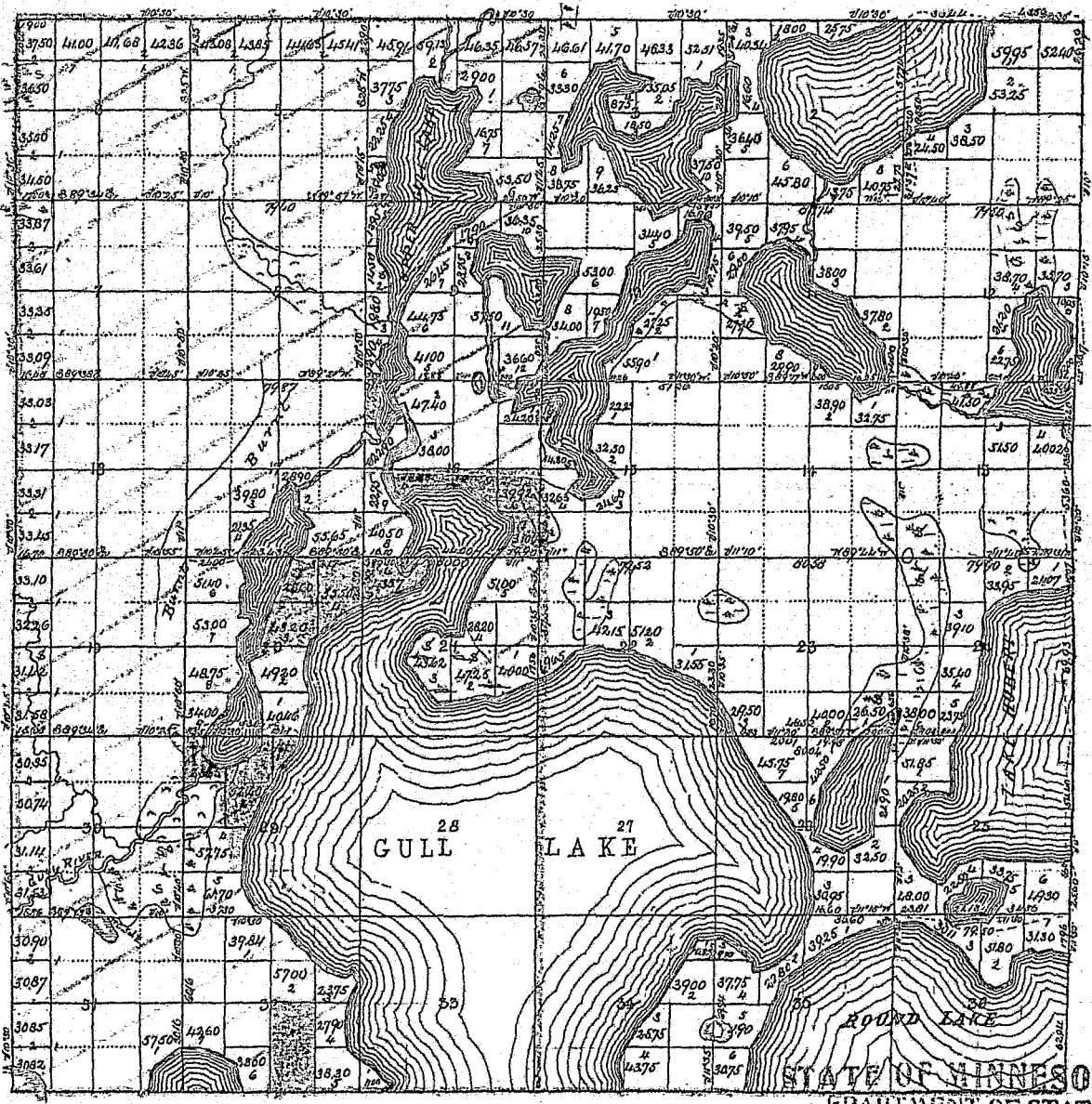

PETITION FOR INCORPORATION OF VILLAGE

To The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Cass, Minnesota:

The undersigned 25 voters, who have resided in the territory hereinafter described for a period of at least two years prior to the date of this petition, hereby petition your honorable board to fix a time and place when and where the resident voters may vote on the proposition of incorporation of such territory as a village to be known by the name of LAKE SHORE. The territory proposed to be incorporated is described as follows:

Sections 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21,
22, 30, 31 and 32, and
lot 1, Section 33,
All in Township 135, Range 29, Cass County, Minnesota.

Such territory consists of land which have been partly platted into lots and blocks, which plats have been duly and legally certified according to the laws of this state and has been filed in the office of the register of deeds of Cass County, the county in which said lands lie, (and the unplatted part of such territory adjoins the platted portion and is so conditioned and properly to be subjected to village government). Such territory contains approximately ten thousand acres of land same being practically all of Lake Shore township, and has been duly ascertained by a census taken under our direction on the 1st day of February, 1947, as appears by the verification hereto.
